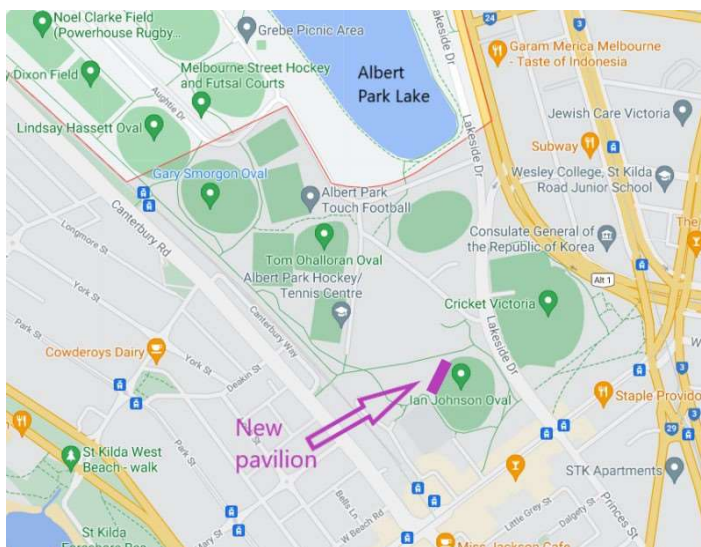


Parks Victoria in partnership with Sport and Recreation Victoria is delivering an exciting new sporting pavilion at Oval One in Albert Park

Once complete, the new pavilion will provide much needed facilities allowing greater use of Oval One by local sporting clubs. The building will also be accessible for local community groups and schools.

The pavilion will be built using the AFL Regional Preferred Facility Guidelines, with features including:

- A pre-fabricated design has been selected which will ensure minimal disruption to neighbouring residents and park users, with a shorter on-site build time. The project includes connecting paths and landscaping.





## Stakeholder engagement

In 2018, following a commitment to improve sport and recreation facilities at Albert Park, Parks Victoria consulted with community sports clubs to help determine how best to meet the growing capacity and demand for sport within the park. The decision to build a sporting pavilion at Oval One is based directly on feedback received.

The insights of users are important, and we will continue to work with local stakeholders, such as the Albert Park Sports User Advisory Group, to provide a contemporary, multi-use, flexible facility that meets current and future community demand.

## Project timeline

- Consultation with key stakeholders:  
October 2020 – January 2021
- Design period:  
December 2020 – March 2021
- Tender and contract engagement:  
April – June 2021
- Construction (initially offsite modular components followed by on-site installation and works):  
July 2021 – June 2022
